



Financial Assistance

It is the firm policy of the GJCC that no one in our community be denied membership because of the inability to pay established dues. Individuals or families are invited to meet confidentially with Membership & Development Director, Dara Freiberg, to discuss adjusted fee arrangements.

Guest Policy

Members are encouraged to bring guests to the facility. Guest fees are \$10/adult per day, \$5/children. If your guest is going to be here for several days, please contact Dara Freiberg to establish a flat fee that agrees with the number of days needed. Guests who are Nashville residents are limited to 3 guest visits per calendar year. Members must accompany their guests.

Dropping Off Children

In order to be in the GJCC building or on the GJCC grounds, children in fourth grade or under must be in a supervised GJCC program or accompanied by a parent, guardian or other adult responsible for their safety.

Restricted Parking Zones

Please do not park in the front circle or preschool entrance. These areas are for discharging and picking up only and the State Fire Marshall's Office mandates clear passage and access for emergency purposes. Specified parking areas are reserved for handicapped and seniors. "Reserved Parking" signs designate these areas.

Use of Photographs

The GJCC reserves the right to use photos taken by its staff on GJCC premises for publicity purposes in its own or other interested publications.

Kosher Policy

All Jewish community groups wishing to use our kitchen facility must conform to the Kashruth policy of the GJCC. A complete set of rules and guidelines is available on request. We ask that all food in the center falls under kosher-style (ie. no meat & dairy together, no pork, and no shellfish).

Class Registration Policy

Registration may be made in person, by mail or on-line. All fees must be paid in full at time of registration. Payment will be accepted in cash, check, or credit card. Membership is required for most classes; non-member fees will be noted.

Register Early to Avoid Class Cancellations

The GJCC reserves the right to cancel a program or class due to insufficient registration or other factors. Full refunds or credit will be made in event of a cancellation. Individuals withdrawing from a class at least one week before the first scheduled meeting date will receive 75% refund of their class fee. Refunds will not be made once a class or activity has met. Class or program fees for any given semester may not be applies to succeeding semesters.



GJCC Severe Weather Policy

If the ECLC is canceled due to inclement weather, activities in the Children's and Health & PE departments will also be cancelled. Decisions on adult activities will be made on an individual basis. Camera and Cell Phone Use

In order to guarantee the privacy of our members, guests, and staff, camera, video camera and cell phone camera usage of any kind is strictly prohibited in the restrooms and locker rooms. Any violation of this policy may result in membership termination, prohibition from use of the facilities and/or legal prosecution by the GJCC.

Membership Renewal/Cancellation

The Membership Agreement is a continuous membership plan, with a minimum commitment of 12 months. After the initial membership period has expired, this Membership Agreement will automatically renew on a month-to-month basis on the terms and conditions stated in this Agreement. Special Note: During initial 12-month period, membership MAY NOT BE CANCELLED prior to the end of the initial membership period except in circumstances of moving/relocation of greater than 50 miles or medical conditions which preclude the member from physically using the facilities and the condition is verified by a physician. Members wishing to cancel their Membership, regardless of length of term, must submit such request in writing at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the term of the term in the Membership Agreement. Member is responsible for payment of all dues and charges for the entire length of this Membership Agreement.

Holds

Memberships may be temporarily placed on hold for up to six (6) months due to medical reasons or travel plans. Written requests for placing your membership on hold must be sent and acknowledged by the Membership Department prior to the beginning of the month that you would like your hold to begin. Memberships for those who pay annually will be extended by the duration of the hold.
