- Respecting the property of others; never engaging in theft or destruction.
- Refraining from harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language or any menacing behavior.
- Adhering to the Gordon JCC's building opening and closing hours and adhering to ECLC's drop off and pick up hours.

Specific incidents will be reviewed by the Conduct Committee. The Gordon JCC reserves the right to take any action it deems appropriate in response to the violation of the above code of conduct. Such actions may include, but are not limited to, removal of violators from the premises and suspension or revocation of membership or certain membership privileges.
